This month we have been looking at kindness. When we open the dictionary to get an understanding of the word it states this: "Kindness is defined as the quality of being friendly, generous, and considerate. Without expecting anything back in return."

Ok, yes, when we think of kindness, we think of a friendly person using friendly words, they may be willing to be generous and they are considerate of others.
